- III. President's Report Kelly Hood
 - III.I. Club Crew Worlds Championship was held in Sarasota in July. It was well run and we had six SRDBA clubs among the competitors; We will share the medal count soon. Nice to have it in our region.
 - III.II. Introduction of new board members

- IV. Vice President's Report Drew Rogers

The Regional Championships, which is tentatively planned for October 1, has been in jeopardy because of a strain between NBP and Pan Am. This has been resolved and, at the moment, there is a plan to have 2 boats sizes (10 and 20 person) and 3 standard Pan Am race divisions 500m, 200m and 2000m races). Registration just opened. SRDBA is a title sponsor for the day. NBP and Pan Am have the contract between them to provide the event. *[Post note update: the Championships have been postponed and we hope to be rescheduled in Spring 2023.]*

We have collected in excess of \$11,000 in dues. Rebates in the amount of \$2,610 were distributed if folks paid by end of March 2022; net rebate has been under \$6,000 this year. We have seen an increase recently in the p/l. Florida Certificate of Exemption arrived; tax exempt for sales tax for buying, but not for individuals buying on behalf of SRDBA.
