## SRDBA REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP Coming this fall!

SRDBA is partnering with Pan Am Dragon Boat to host the 2022 SRDBA Regional Championship on Saturday, October 1, 2022 at Nathan Benderson Park, Sarasota FL. This will be a stand-alone championship, so results will not fold into an International/Worlds Championship berth, but WILL incorporate a SRDBA-Clubs-Only competitive component (i.e. Regional Bragging Rights) within the PanAm competition parameters.

The 2022 SRDBA Regional Championship welcomes ALL teams and ALL levels of Dragon Boater paddlers, and if we get enough interest, will include Community/Corporate teams, Competitive Festival teams, and Special Interest teams (BCP, ACP, Paradragons, and Youth). We are also pleased to announce that we will have the new Senior D division (70+) for this competition.

The race course will feature 200 meter, 500 meter & 2000 meter race lengths with both 10-person boat and 20-person boat classes. Team medals will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, 3rd places by race length and class. SRDBA will recognize Division Champions with 2022 trophies for those teams from clubs that are in good standing as SRDBA 2022 Club Members.

### Membership Contributed by Annely Thorstad

It has been a very busy first quarter receiving and entering memberships, answering questions, preparing stats and completing the rebates for clubs. Each club who is a paid member received a \$10 rebate for every individual member who paid on or before March 31st, up to a maximum of \$300.00. And yes! You are still welcome to become a 2022 member, your membership will just no longer be eligible for the Club Rebate is all. We currently have 57% of membership paid in relation to last year, with approximately \$2,500 in rebates going out this year.

Most membership inquiries were regarding the ability to list more than one club for individual memberships, and whether or not membership is annual from the date of payment. Unfortunately, we must only list one club per paddler, which is the paddler's choice, and membership runs in the calendar year, not from the date of payment.

As this is the second year using our new member data collection spreadsheet, new columns have been added to capture the number of new and returning paddlers, as well as a payment ID column that helps team captains and coaches identify paddlers who are currently in good standing and those who have yet to pay their annual membership. I also have begun creating fun fact Facebook posts using the data collected.

### 🗽 Youth Engagement Committee 🗽

Introducing youth programs will ensure the future of the sport in our region. (Hint: Look at our stats. Soon Senior D will be our fastest growing demgraphic!) Having a youth program not only helps to grow the sport in our region, but it can also be a recruitment tool for parents to join your club. And can you imagine having local or regional events with competing youth programs? Maybe have a category with Senior Cs and Ds and their grandkids in the same boat racing against regional rivals!? How fun would that would be?!

Ideally, a youth program would involve complimentary membership at least for the first year, but parents and guardians would also be encouraged to join. The adult fee for this group would be left up to the discretion of your club.

We have some clubs that are interested in starting a youth program, but have voiced concerns about insurance coverage. With a signed athlete waiver, your current policy through Liquori Associates includes coverage for all ages!

In order to start a youth program, clubs will need to be able to provide coaching and equipment (paddles, PFDs, boats). SRDBA will provide marketing materials you can share with local schools that you feel may be open to promoting participation among their students. Encourage competition between area schools!
